Consultation meeting with young LGBTI activists

The "Consultation meeting with young LGBTI activists" was strategically designed to achieve a twofold objective: firstly, to enhance the understanding of young activists about the challenges confronted by LGBTI elders, and secondly, to collaboratively devise impactful advocacy strategies for addressing these pressing elder-related issues. The event garnered significant participation, attracting a diverse cohort of 45 attendees. This inclusive gathering on August 11, 2023, encompassed young activists hailing from the LGBTI community, dedicated project personnel, and a notable representation of elders from different provinces. Through dynamic discussions and shared insights, the consultation meeting aimed to bridge generational perspectives, fostering a concerted effort to pave the way for a more supportive and inclusive environment for LGBTI.



The consultation meeting aimed to foster collaboration and dialogue, culminating in the establishment of an intergenerational network under Mitini's leadership, thereby paving the way for a more supportive and inclusive environment for LGBTI elders. The session's key objectives included reintroducing the LGBTI Elders Advancing Initiative (LEAP), assessing young activists' engagement with elder issues, gathering feedback from elders, and outlining the groundwork for the intergenerational network.
